# **Application Form**

The application form can be downloaded from <u>the website of the MEYS</u>. The applicants are required to submit the completed application forms along with their CVs in Czech or English to the appropriate Czech Embassies or other institutions responsible for selecting the candidates recommended for the awards.

# **Selection of Candidates**

The selection of candidates for scholarship awards falls within the terms of reference of the relevant Embassy of the Czech Republic or the appropriate foreign partner institution. The MEYS fully respects the nomination and does not perform any further selection. Please inform the applicants of the results.

# Nomination of Candidates

Before presenting the nomination to the MEYS, please check carefully that the candidates are **at least 18 years old** and that they are **assigned to a school featuring on the list of slots offered to the partner country concerned**. The schools and the number of scholarship slots are specified in the cover letter.

#### Nomination of Substitute Candidates

Applicants, who were not selected as regular candidates for the scholarship awards, may be recommended as substitute nominees. The chance of their admission has been high in recent years. Substitutes may also admitted to different schools than those originally offered to the country concerned.

#### **Online Registration**

The Embassy or another relevant partner institution should also inform the selected regular candidates and substitutes of the requirement to register themselves and file an online application for the scholarship online at:

The SSSS registration portal will be open **from 15 March 2025 till 31 March 2025**. The online applications, which must be submitted before the deadline, will be forwarded to the MEYS for review. Based on the official nomination, the MEYS will assess the online applications and forward them to the relevant summer schools, which will then contact the candidates and substitutes directly.



# **Admission Schedule**

- 15 March 2025 opening of the online registration portal
- **31 March 2025** deadline for submitting nominations to the MEYS by the appropriate authorities in the eligible countries as well as for the registration and online applications of the recommended regular candidates and substitutes
- April 2025 assessment of the submitted applications by the MEYS
- May, June, July 2025 the organisers of summer school courses contact admitted scholarship-holders and substitutes

# Withdrawal of Application/Resignation

If any of the officially nominated and accepted SSSS participants is not able to attend the summer course due to unforeseen reasons, he/she is obliged to inform the MEYS Department of International Relations and European Union without delay, by sending a message to <u>Magdalena.VillatoroSladkova@msmt.gov.cz</u> as well as to the relevant contact person at the summer school concerned. Please note that the chance of substitutes to utilise the free slots depends on a timely notification of regular candidates' resignation.
